In accordance with the Secretary of State Regulations the 2022 VOTES Act the City of Worcester will be opening and/or depositing early voted ballots in the Levi Lincoln Chamber, 455 Main Street, Worcester at the following sessions:

- 1. Saturday, August 31st, 8:30 AM – 8:00 PM Worcester City Hall, Levi Lincoln Chamber, 3rd Floor**
- 2. Sunday, September 1st, 8:30 AM – 8:00 PM Worcester City Hall, Levi Lincoln Chamber, 3rd Floor (IF NECESSARY)**

Observers must register by emailing clerk@worcesterma.gov in advance of all processing of early voted ballots sessions.

In accordance with the Secretary of State Regulations the 2022 VOTES Act, no results shall be determined or announced until after the time the polls close on September 3rd, 2024. At that time the results from the advance processed ballots will be added to the Election Day results.
