Proposed Amendment #3 to the 2020 to 2024 TIP Highway List

- Reduce cost of Project #608764 UPTON RECONSTRUCTION OF HARTFORD AVENUE NORTH AND HIGH STREET. Currently programmed cost is \$5,717,250. New project cost is \$4,487,158, a decrease of \$1,230,092.
- Remove project #602659 CHARLTON OXFORD RECONSTRUCTION ON ROUTE 20, FROM RICHARDSON'S CORNER EASTERLY TO ROUTE 12, INCLUDES REHAB OF C-06-023 & REPLACEMENT OF O-06-002 from 2020 & 2021. This project will be reprogrammed in 2022 in the 2021—2025 TIP.
- Project #607733 AUBURN REHABILITATION OF AUBURN STREET, FROM WALSH AVENUE TO MILLBURY STREET will be moved from 2021 into 2020 and there will be an increase in cost. Currently programmed cost is \$3,145,955.
 New project cost is \$4,765,372, an increase of \$1,619,417.
- Add Project #606701 STURBRIDGE CULVERT REPLACEMENT @ ROUTE 20 & SNELL STREET to 2020. Total cost of project is \$4,189,910.
- Add Project #608191 WEST BROOKFIELD SIDEWALK AND WHEELCHAIR CONSTRUCTION ON ROUTE 9 to 2020. Total cost of project is \$924,995.
- Remove Project #609106 DOUGLAS NORTHBRIDGE SUTTON –
 UXBRIDGE PAVEMENT PRESERVATION ON ROUTE 146 from 2020. Total
 cost of project is \$13,452,000. This project will be advertised as Non-Federal Aid
 (NFA).
- Add Project WRTA001 WORCESTER REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY SERVICE BETWEEN WEBSTER AND SOUTHBRIDGE to 2020. Total cost of project is \$363,000. \$290,400 is federal funding while \$72,600 is the local match by the WRTA SCA.
- Add Project WRTA002 WORCESTER REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY –
 WESTBOROUGH DEMAND RESPONSE RIDESHARE SERVICE PILOT to
 2020. \$200,000 of the total cost would be programmed in 2020. The remaining
 \$432,032 would be programmed in 2021 of the 2021-2025 TIP highway project
 listing.

701 CMR 7.00 Use of Road Flaggers and Police Details on Public Works Projects / 701 CMR 7.00 (the Regulation) was promulgated and became law on October 3, 2008. Under this Regulation, the CMR is applicable to any Public works Project that is performed within the limits of, or that impact traffic on, any Public Road. The Municipal Limitation referenced in this Regulation is applicable only to projects where the Municipality is the Awarding Authority. For all projects contained in the TIP, the Commonwealth is the Awarding Authority. Therefore, all projects must be considered and implemented in accordance with 701 CMR 7.00, and the Road Flagger and Police Detail Guidelines. By placing a project on the TIP, the Municipality acknowledges that 701 CMR 7.00 is applicable to its project and design and construction will be fully compliant with this Regulation. 701 CMR 7.00 Use of Road Flaggers and Police Details on Public Works Projects / 701 CMR 7.00 (the Regulation) was promulgated and became law on October 3, 2008. Under this Regulation, the CMR is applicable to any Public works Project that is performed within the limits of, or that impact traffic on, any Public Road. The Municipal Limitation referenced in this Regulation is applicable only to projects where the Municipality is the Awarding Authority. For all projects contained in the TIP, the Commonwealth is the Awarding Authority. Therefore, all projects must be considered and implemented in accordance with 701 CMR 7.00, and the Road Flagger and Police Detail Guidelines. By placing a project on the TIP, the Municipality acknowledges that 701 CMR 7.00 is applicable to its project and design and construction will be fully compliant with this Regulation.
